General Information

- 1. A PC is required to perform this step.
- 2. Use the wired LAN or Wireless(sums-wireless) when accessing from on-campus. When you set up from off-campus, please access VPN first.
- 3. Multi-factor authentication is required when accessing to Gmail and VPN from off-campus.
